



Photo and Video Competition - Terms and Conditions

1. To enter this competition entrants are required to submit a photo or “highlights reel” style video taken on a WorldStrides tour. Entrants will be required to submit their entries via an online entry form, where they will also have to submit their personal details including their name, school name, tour name, address, email address and the photo / video location.
2. By entering the competition, entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
3. The Terms and Conditions of this competition are governed by the laws of the State of Victoria.
4. The competition is being run by WorldStrides at 264 Keilor Road, Essendon North, Victoria, 3041.
5. The competition is called the “WorldStrides Photo & Video Competition” and commences at 9am Australian Eastern Standard Time (EST) on Saturday 28/04/2018.
6. The closing time for entering the competition is 5pm EST on Saturday 28/07/2018.
7. Entry to the competition is limited to Australian residents only. Prizes will not be shipped overseas.
8. Entrants under the age of 16 years must obtain parental consent to enter the competition and must declare on the Competition’s online entry form that he or she has his or her parent’s or guardian’s consent to enter the Competition.
9. All photo submission must have a title and student details.
10. Students can submit up to three photos per category.
11. Photos can be submitted for (3) three different categories, which will all be judged against different criteria. The categories are:
 - a) Group photos – Show us the smiling faces of your classmates as you’re having the time of your life on tour.
 - b) Outdoor adventures – Whether you’re immersed in breathtaking scenery or challenging your comfort zone outdoors, these photos capture your greatest experiences in the natural world.
 - c) Cultural activities – Whether it’s unfamiliar environments, interactions with the locals and traditional celebrations, these photos encapsulate your experience of a different culture.
12. Students can submit a short video featuring the highlights from their WorldStrides tour.
13. Students can submit one or two videos and all video submissions must come with student details.
14. The video winner and winners in the photo categories cannot be the same person.
15. Videos must adhere to the following guidelines:
 - a) Videos must be 1 – 2 minutes.
 - b) Video quality must be 720p or above.
 - c) The video cannot be publicly displayed through any means and cannot violate privacy, publicity or intellectual property rights.
 - d) The video cannot contain any inappropriate behaviour, unlawful activity, drinking, nudity or swearing.
 - e) Videos must use music legally. Students can create their own music, get written permission from the artist or sample free music from any of these websites:
 - a) Incompetech: Donation based, free music
 - b) Danosong: Pay what you feel is fair
 - c) Mobygratis: Free music for non-commercial films
 - d) Jamendo: Creative Commons Music - Video cannot exceed 1 GB
 - e) Youtube Royalty Free Audio Library
16. The prize for the winning video submission will be a \$500 visa gift card.
17. The prize for the winning photo submission in each category will be a \$150 visa gift card.
18. Each of the three photo categories will have only one winning photo each.



19. Entry to the competition is free. Entrants will be responsible for all costs associated with entering the competition, which may include costs associated with accessing the internet.
20. Photo and video entries must be taken by the entrant submitting them and not by any other source.
21. Entries must be student's own original video or photo taken during a 2018 WorldStrides tour.
22. Entrants must obtain consent from all parties included in the submitted photo or video.
23. The team at WorldStrides will select photo and video finalists from each category based on image composition, resolution and overall quality, candidness, significance of content, originality, creativity, and overall presentation
24. Other technical judging criteria for images include – colour, composition, lighting and emotion.
25. Other technical judging criteria for video include – simple editing, no excessive zooming or transitions, no shaky footage, clear and engaging audio without background noise, only one aspect ratio and orientation.
26. The judging team will be comprised of at least 3 members.
27. The prize winner will be contacted within seven (7) days of the selection process by the email address supplied by the entrant on the entry form.
28. If the prize winner does not respond to claim the prize within fourteen (14) days of the selection, a re-selection will be conducted within twenty one (21) days of the original selection date, in the same location, and with the same method. Re-selection will continue in the same manner until all prizes have been claimed by prize winners.
29. Entrants can only win one prize in the photo competition.
30. The prize may be collected in person by the prize winner or may be mailed/couriered.
31. If a prize winner who has been contacted and been made aware of their prize winning, and has agreed to collect the prize or for which collection is the only method for receiving the prize, does not collect the prize within twenty-one (21) days of this contact, a re-selection will be conducted within thirty (30) days of the original selection date through the same method.
32. The prize winner may be required to provide evidence of their identity (such as photographic ID, birth certificate or current passport) when receiving the prize.
33. The prize is not transferrable.
34. The prize winner's name will be published on Facebook. By entering the competition, entrants grant WorldStrides permission to use their full name on Facebook.
35. Entry into the competition signifies acceptance of all conditions. Entrants are required to abide by the Terms and Conditions as presented.
36. Entry into the competition signifies acceptance of all conditions by the parent or guardian on behalf of entrant's under the age of 16. The awarding of the winning entry to an entrant under the age of 16 is subject to confirmation of parent or guardian consent to these terms and conditions.
